Light it up, Ninja - Yokohama, Japan



The city of Yokohama recently became the stage of the spectacular light event, 'Light it up, Ninja', an event set up by one of Japan's most influential lighting planning offices, LPA (Lighting Planners Associates Inc). The unique name reflects the concept of the event; all planning was done secretly and the event was not announced until the official start. A beautiful landscape in the bay area of Yokohama was chosen, surrounded by an old railway line. Using Traxon's Wash XB-18 RGB, renowned for its high brightness LEDs creating rich wall-washing effects, a unique lighting concept was set up for the antique bridge stretching across the bay. The lighting fixtures are installed inside the bridge trusses, illuminating the metal framework with colorful light. Controlled by Traxon's stunning Light-Drive RGB, a simplistic plug 'n' play controller permitting to discretely tune color and brightness of LED fixtures in two separated lighting zones, the installation is easy to operate while splendid in effect. Smartly combining history with modern spirit, the antique bridge has been turned into a piece of contemporary art.
